The second and third trainings address the staff and focus on solid waste management and wastewater management. Through these trainings, you and all your team will have a greater understanding of how to run your business reducing its negative impact on the environment.

DEFINE SOLUTIONS

Based on the evaluation of your business's current practices, we will guide you through the necessary steps to take in order to reduce your negative environmental impact. Together, we will draw up a working plan with short and long-term priorities to facilitate the implementation of the solutions.

These are the practices you commit to implementing in your business to contribute to the ocean's health and become an Ocean Friendly • Manage solid waste appropriately: recycle plastic, aluminium, tetrapack, business(b):

and glass. Dispose your organic waste properly (composting it or giving it to an organic waste collector). Dispose of your trash in a suitable waste container.

- Manage wastewater appropriately: you need an adequate wastewater treatment system for the grey and black water your business generates.
 Septic sludge must be handled by authorized companies.
- Correctly dispose of your grease trap waste and used kitchen oil by giving them to an authorized waste manager.
- Using alternative cleaning products is mandatory.
- Single-use plastics should be avoid: you cannot sell or use plastic or bioplastic straws, cups, cutlery, take away containers, bags, bottles, bathroom accessories.
- Comply with Costa Rica's current legislation concerning the relevant matter.

We will go through the details of all the criteria above mentioned in the trainings.

Once your business's environmental impact is clear and that the solutions to implement are understood, we will provide you with the necessary tools to take action.


